We have the same team together so we will be able to build upon last years excellent vibes and feedback.

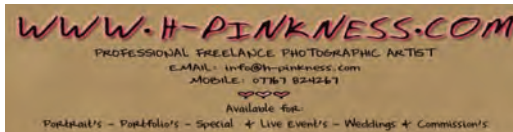
It didn't all go to plan last year and we had a few problems to iron out and address this year which we are doing.

KOZMIK STAGE *FRIDAY*

THE GLISS ORCHESTRA 12-12.45PM

Last seen at GONG Uncon in Holland this will be the first time they have played in UK. As then the band will be made up of musicians available to play. They will be directed by Brian Abbott (Invisible Opera Company of Tibet UK) and the legendary Mic Cosmic.

Expect something unexpected.



SPIRAL SCOUTS 1.15-2PM

Spiral Scouts are more of a collective than a band, playing their own brand of funky folk, and acoustic giggerypoker. The songs are penned by George Spittal, and made into what they become by the talents of the rest of the musicians involved.

LUNAR SEED 4-5PM

Lunar Seed is a producer of electronic music with a distinctly psychedelic flavour. Music for dancing to, without necessarily fitting into any of the myriad genres of "Dance Music". Music which he hopes may take you on inner journeys of mystery and imagination.

For the last few years, Lunar Seed has been rocking dancefloors at parties, clubs and festivals, in Britain and Europe.



microcosmics SACRED GEOMETRY BAND 5.30-6.30PM

Thanks to a perfect balance between electronic and natural instruments, Microcosmics Sacred Geometry Band creates a unique world ambient cosmic music. While it borders on New age meditative music, it never fall into insipid background music. Several climates are developped through the different pieces: acid, celestial and always ethereal thanks to the floating synths This is cerebral music for higher states of consciousness.



NUKLI 7-8PM

NUKLI are veterans of the golden age of free festivals. A time when bands were experimenting with long flowing improvisations, developing a sound that matched the state of mind of the audience: spaced out!

They started as a space punk band PSi seen on many stages at the Stonehenge festival, mutating over the years, first into PSi NUKLI, with NUKLI eventually spinning off to follow a path that led to the landmark Time Factory release on Delerium records.

Live, NUKLI appeared many times at Club Dog and the Sonic Relief gigs, as well as playing at many a squat party and benefit gig.



KOZMIK STAGE *FRIDAY*

SENDELICA 8.45-9.45PM

SENDELICA are an unashamed psychedelic trio of Pete Bingham on guitars & electronics, Glenda Pescado on bass and Paul Fields on drums. Hailing from Wales, they are an experimental outfit whose work is in some sense reminiscent of early Pink Floyd psychedelic outings mixed up with occasional heavy riffing, and late Orb dub-ambient musings. The band had their first *TheOwlsHaveEyes* EP released in July 2006. They played at several festivals in the UK before resuming work on their debut album. The album, entitled *Entering The Rainbow Light* was finished in December and was released at the end of January 2007. Their new album 'The Satori In Elegance of the Majestic Stonegazer' is out June 11th on FRG Records.



OMNIA OPERA 10.30-MIDNIGHT

OMNIA OPERA formed in 1985 when musicians from local Kidderminster bands joined forces.

In the following years they played numerous gigs and supported outfits such as Cardiacs and The Pink Fairies.

Their self-titled debut album was issued in 1993. Just after that the band split-up though, and for one reason or another the second CD, *Red Shift*, didn't see the light of day until 1997 - three years after Omnia Opera ceased to be as a band.

Despite not being offered million dollar contracts Omnia Opera reformed in 2006, after what the band themselves describe as a brief pause lasting for 12 years.

Their third album, *Nothing Is Ordinary*, was released in 2011.

Initially, The Tea Project was a side band for Tony Hands and Dean E Holt (ex TFTW) but they finally got together with ex SilverSPACE drummer Bongolious Maximus whereby the band was finally forged. The band have been booked to play various festivals around the UK for the coming year. . . . and gigs are imminent within the next few months.



DEVIANT AMPS 7-8PM

Deviant Amps are a 3-piece indie psychedelic rock band who have built up a good live reputation over the last few years. They came together as a three piece in 2006 releasing the Giving It All Away ep.

They still found time to help provide the P.A. staging and lighting for Stonehenge free festival every year! It cost them a lot of money and effort, but that festival was a creature very close to their collective free-floating-anarchic heart.

KOZMIK STAGE SUNDAY

SCHROEDINGERS CAT 12-12.45PM

Schroedinger's Cat was formed in 1988 by Busking Flatfoot Iain in Rome, Italy. Iain had some troubles with the cops, so he had to leave Italy and reformed the band in Germany. He didn't find suitable musicians so he played all the instruments himself.

Schroedingers Cat have recently returned to live performances again and Kozfest are pleased to announce that they will be playing the Kozmik stage this year.



SPIRITS OF THE EARTH 1.15-2PM

Formed in 2006 out of appreciation of our love for the ether and space rock. Our first CD, "Spirits of the Earth" was released in 2007, followed by an appearance at Eastern Haze festival with Ozric Tentacles and Space Ritual. The Maxi-CD "Not Coming Back" was released in 2008 to coincide with our appearance at Hawkfest. 2009 saw our first appearance at Cosmic Puffin and our homecoming to The Railway at Bromley. 2009 also saw us begin work on our first album to be released early 2010.



APACHE JOHN BAND 2.30-3.30PM

The Apache John Band is fusion of acoustic folk, blues, rock and late 60's psychedelia. Sometimes theatrical, sometimes dark and moody, sometimes amusing; a band that carries the spirit of the festival with mainly original songs and music which can be sung and played around a festival fire as easily as on any stage.

The current Apache John Band line-up came together in March 2008. Apache John & Amazon Jan called on Andi & Julia, who were more than happy to take up their current positions in the line up.

GREEN RITUAL 4-5PM

Originally featuring Nik Turner and the late Judge Trev and strictly no rehearsals.

These guys capture the pure excitement of 70s space rock and adopted the name Green Ritual as a festival only jamming band the only qualification is they have all studied and performed with the original 'masters'.

More than just a covers band, clearly, the next generation or children of the sun.



WHIMWISE 5.30-6.30PM

Whimwise is a unique act. Building from an electronic rock based core sound, combined with acoustic/orchestral instrumentalists and all set off against the celtic ambient moodscapes of Mexican world-music vocalist, Alquimia. Flying in the face of fashion and blinkered straitjackets, Whimwise just about runs the gamut of all known styles, blending merging and diverging various genres and musical approaches. Orchestral, space rock, avant gard, electronic, celtic, experimental, jazz, world music influences - they've all being sprinkled into brew, creating something quite new. A fusion and a melting pot - Whimwise pride themselves on being unclassifiable!



SHOM 7-8PM

Experimental. Progressive.

Shom are a psychedelic band led by Mick Shom.

Mick will usually hook up with whoever is playing the gig that day.

Expect some surprises and some intense tunes to get you going on a Sunday summers evening!



KOZMIK STAGE SUNDAY

KRANKSHAFT 8.45-9.45PM

During 1980, Inner City Unit played a month long residency at London's Marquee Club, Robert Calvert was the support act for each show, members of ICU would don masks and become "Krankschaft".

To mark the 20th anniversary of Roberts passing a show was organised by Nik Turner in Herne Bay featuring many people who had played with Robert. We felt it was only right that we should donate our time and effort to once more perform his sonnets and poems using their original DNA.

Following an invitation from Hawkwind to play a series of gigs on their 2010 summer tour we wanted to expand the line up as a duo isn't very rock & roll.. So Mick Stupp who Fred & Steve have played with under many names rejoined his mates and brought the raw power of lives drums to the live line up.



PARADISE 9 10.30-MIDNIGHT

Paradise 9 are Gregg McKella on main vocals, guitar, glissando guitar, psychedelic clarinet backing vocals, Neil Matthars on bass, Tyrone Thomas (ex-Alternative TV) on lead guitar and Jaki Windmill (Mick Farren, ex-Whimwise, ex Space Ritual) djembe/backing vocals. Paradise 9 have been described as cutting edge, space-rock-stroke-punk-rock-stroke-space-dub-stroke-space-core.

They regularly feature guests performances in their live sets, including Nik Turner, Miss Angel Flame, Ron Tree, Jeanette Murphy, Lord Sealand Armstrong - theremin, Kev Ellis (Bubbledubble/ex Dr Brown), Wayne Collyer on percussion (original P9 stixman) and Nik Nimbus (Here & Now) drums. The late great Judge Trev Thoms (Inner City Unit), also occasionally joined them on lead. Paradise 9 feel honoured to have JudgeTrev feature on their last EP " State Of The Nation".



JUDGE TREV STAGE *FRIDAY*

THE BALANCE MAN 12.30-1.30PM

Band members and instruments played: Darryl Thorne, guitar and vocals and sometimes a stomp box for rhythmic accompaniment.

If possibly Darryl will find a random drummer and bass player (if i can drag anyone along) and hopefully Kev Ellis on blues harp and diddy bow.

The Balance Man sings the blues!



GLOW PEOPLE 2-3PM

Improviseational and spacey, with a touch of jazz, Shropshire's Glowpeople have come a long way since their inception just over two years ago.

Formed from a core of experienced musicians, and pulling in a variety of guests as and when needed, their style is the perfect soundtrack to a lazy summer's afternoon, basking in the sunshine, with shards of psych energy flitting through the air and into your brain.



XOO 3.30-4.30PM

Xoo combine metal and rock influences, together with space and progressive traditions, to create a potent new sound. They acknowledge their heritage, yet they are not retro. Their trademark sound is that of classic rock guitar, driving basslines and drumming, but layered with synth textures and electronic patterns. Most recognisable is their rich, melodic, harmony vocal sound and catchy, memorable song writing.

Xoo have started to make a name for themselves on the festival and live venue scene, through their live performances and album 'Poison in the Name of Beauty'.



JUDGE TREV STAGE *FRIDAY*

THE TIME LORDS 5-6PM

After playing Kozfest 2011 with the Starfighters, Dani and Steve found themselves floating free but adrift in autumn 2011. An inspired, extremely spacey jam, Decoding The Senses, needed posting and it needed a name. So The Timelords of old were reborn on SoundAwesome as 2 very experienced but under-gigged musos just itching to get out on the road. Steve and Dani both handle guitar/synth/voice. With the addition of Sammy P and Sam H on bass and drums the sound has become a psychedelic punky rock and rollin space-out groove.(!)

An album is due, and a track "Rough Diamond" will be on the forthcoming "Allies & Clansmen" CD available from Omenopus.



TRIBE OF CRO 6.30-7.30PM

Formed in 1995, a genuine cult band, The Tribe of Cro are one of the unsung heroes of the underground festival scene. For over 15 years they have been waving their freak flag high to the sound of free festival psychedelics, driving krautrock rhythms, spacey liquid electronica soaked in a skip load of stoner riffing guitars. From the tops of mountains to the depths of Eastern Europe TOC have played many of the major underground and psychedelic festivals in UK and Europe.



DR. HASBEEN 8-9PM

Formed in 1996/7 by founder member Martyn Hasbeen they released first album Last orders in 1997. Several acclaimed cd releases followed. Finally a double Cd was release on Black Widow records featuring chosen tracks from the CD releases. Now with a stable line up and new official releases on the Sonic rock music label, 15 years on & the spaceship Hasbeen still bodily go were no man have been before.

BUBBLEDUBBLE 9.30-10.30PM

Kev Ellis: Vocals, maff organ, chaos pad, radios, infact, anything lying around that could possibly make a sound, chaos, and that friggin' green stick he waves about that was once a pick axe (we're trying to sell the patent to the C.I.A. to replace thier waterboard torture technique so as they don't fall too far foul of international law)!

Andy Radburn: Programming, Synths and spacey noises

Born from the ashes of cult band Her Majesty's Secret Goblin in 2001 they produced a string of impressive releases before going on hiatus. In 2009 they returned to work with producer & visual artist Jon Aldersea creating the perfect mix of visuals & hard edged post psychedelic rock.



ANDY BOLE 2-3PM

Andy is a professional musician and has played Europe and America with members of Fairport Convention, Gong, Blowzabella, Electric Light Orchestra, Dave Stewart and Mike Oldfield. He studied the Hansa Veena with Indian musician Barun Kumar Pal. As a solo artist Andy has produced seven critically acclaimed solo albums. His masterly playing of the Bouzouki and Weissenborn acoustic slide guitar is in regular demand for use on many television and film soundtrack work.



JUDGE TREV STAGE SATURDAY

CHUMLEY WARNER BROS 3.30-4.30PM

Bridget Wishart has been involved in artistic and musical projects for the last 30 years. Over the years she has played with Next Year's Big Thing, Hippy Slags, Daze, Technopagan and Hawkwind.

In the early 2000's she was approached by Don Falcone to collaborate with Spirits Burning. This led to several home recorded collaborations including Earthborn, Bloodlines and Djinn with Alan Davey, among others. Requests came in for Bridget to appear at various live events across the country. Family commitments didn't allow many appearances but the urge to sing live again was growing.

Martin Plumley has played guitar since 1977. He started to support Bridget in songwriting and arrangement and set up their home studio. Together they started work on songs for a live set.



MANIKIN TIMESHARK 5-6PM

The timeshark has been a band with many line-ups formed in 2004. A stable line-up has been together since 2011. The band are building a good live reputation.

Manikin Timeshark are progressive rock / space rock / drum 'n' bass / ambient / jazz.....all of these and more!

Spiral Navigators (featuring "Cosmic" Andy (Fricker), Rich Eagleweb, Ash Tuck, Tim Crosby, Bo Meson, Katie Lee, Kim Sears, Rob Tarana
DNA: The Galaxy.

Formed in 2007 by Bass Druid Cosmic Andy (Space Pirates/Psychik Hatters) and Rich Eagleweb (Tarana/Vestiges of Humanity)..

On a mission to unite the Multifariouschannels of their shared musical ancestry...."If we can get some Righteous Heavy Space-Boogie together.....".



AURORA 8-9PM

A glow of pulsing tripped out electro beats and kalieidoscopic synthscapes..

The three- piece band have taken their space-rock and anarcho-punk roots and infused them with an array of electronics to create otherworldly live progressive trance and psychedelic electro. Expect waves of shimmering guitar effects, cascading acid arpeggios and deep tranced- out throbbing beats launching into the heavens.



LITMUS 9.30-11PM

Litmus ARE spacerock for the 21st century. A collection of throbbing bass, pounding drums, searing guitar, swirling keyboards and screeching electronics. They are here to open heads and re-calibrate minds.

Live shows are an audio-visual extravaganza of projections, images and sounds, all taking the audience on a journey to the far reaches of both outer and inner space. Their debut CD was called "You Are Here". The band's second CD "Planetfall" was released in April 2007. The third album "Aurora" was released in August 2009.

A massively powerful live presence, Litmus need to be seen to be believed!

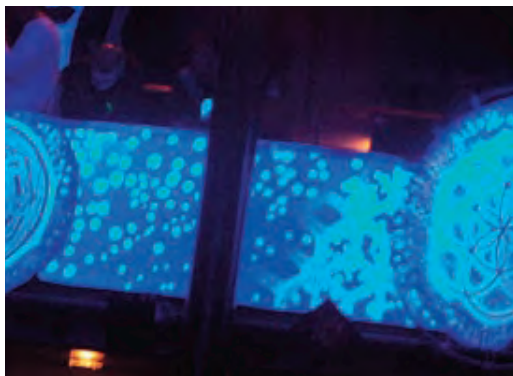

Together they brought out the next Zetan Spore albums, "Visitation" in 1997 and were then signed to Aardvark Records, where they have so far released another eight albums: "The Pillars of Creation" (1998), "Subspace Distortions" (1999), "Outer Space Hopper Safari" (2001), "Transwarp Audio Head Drive" (2002), "Burn Up" (2004), "Escape Velocity" (2005), "Flux" (2007) and new for 2010, "Tribes of the Stars" - their most exciting release to date.

Since their first gig in 1997 they have kept their set-up almost entirely hardware-based for live performance and after playing hundreds of gigs over the coming years, have remained one of the few genuinely live psytrance acts around.

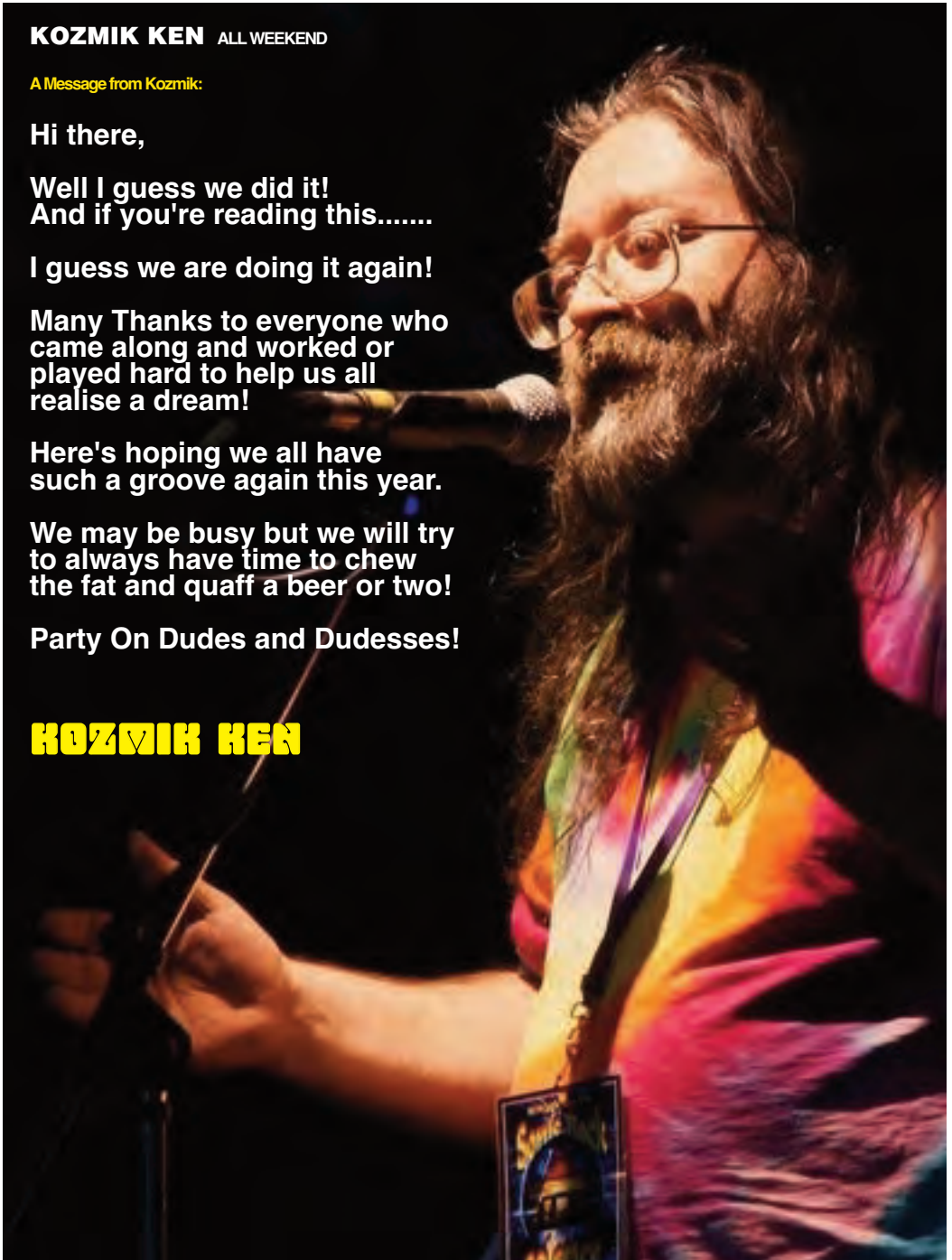

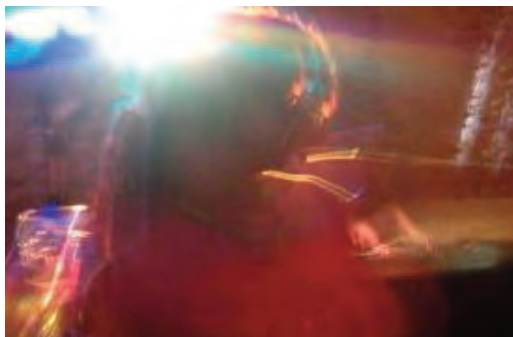
FRIDAY STEVE BUBBLE



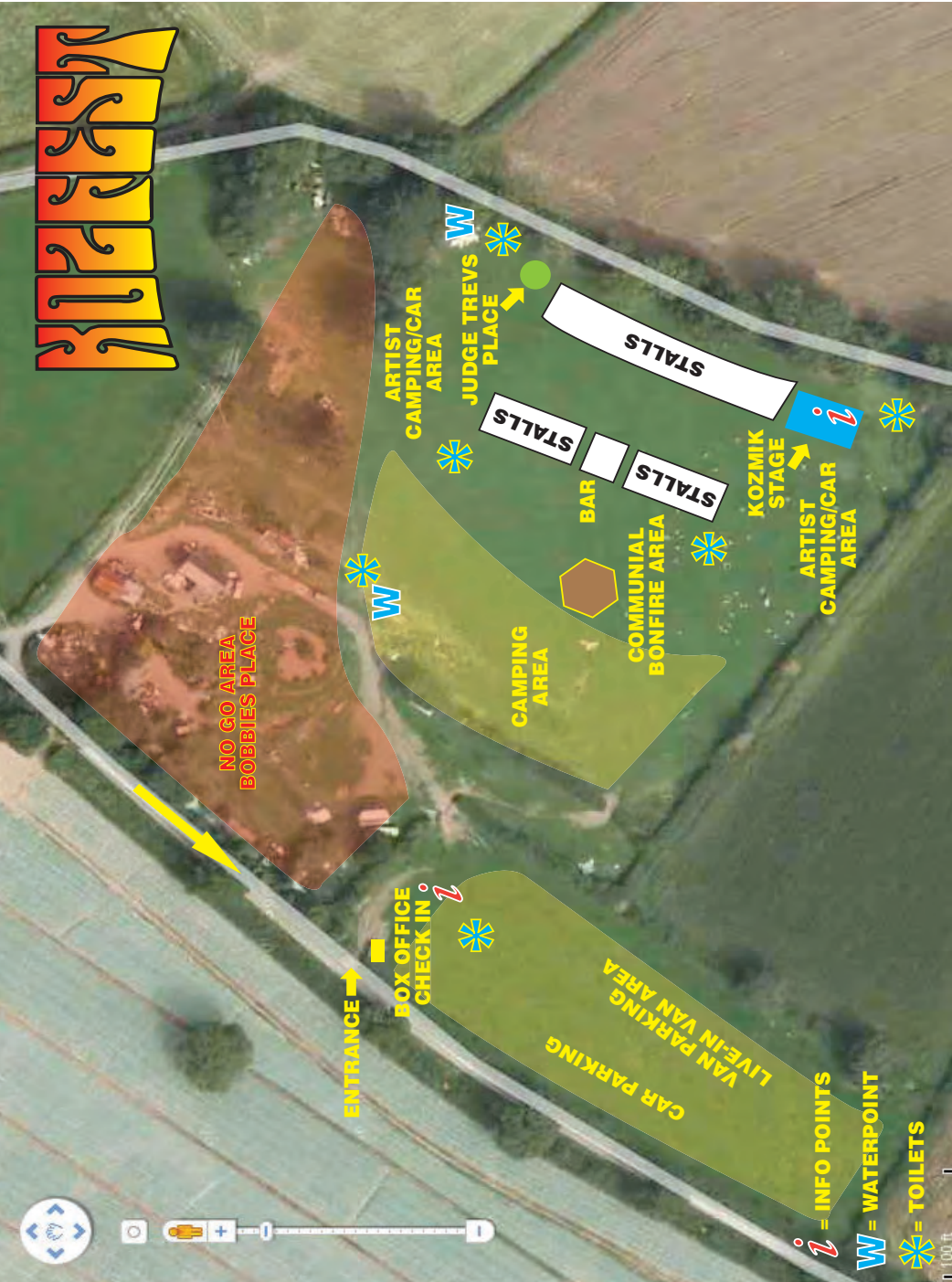
