Enter Royston 'Stone' Naylor and Bobbie Wattsfest. Royston suggested that I ask Bobbie if we could hold a festival on his land. As we had played Bobbies Wattsfest festival a few times I thought a phone call just to see wouldn't go amiss. So I rang him and he said "hell yes, have a festival here.....GET ON MY LAND!". We managed to set up the site infrastructure and the bands did the rest by agreeing to play this festival. It will be a totally unique festival and has been built up out of the goodwill and love for Kozmik Ken. A true legend in the Space Rock world. It is also a very rare opportunity for us all to get together and put faces to names etc, to party and celebrate psychedelic rock.

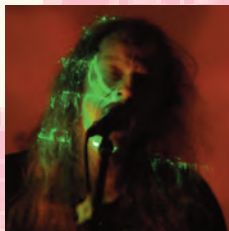

SENDELICA

Main Stage Friday 12 Noon

SENDELICA are based in and around Cardigan, Wales, AND are an instrumental psyche-space-rock band whose work blends early psychedelic outings, occasional heavy riffing, and electronic ambient musings. The core band is: Pete Bingham on guitars & electronics (ex- KALD), Glenda Pescado on bass (THE SURF MESSENGERS and ex- NIK TURNER'S ALL STARS), Paul Fields on drums, and Lee Relfe on sax. The band had their debut *TheOwlsHaveEyes* EP released in July 2006 which was followed by *Entering The Rainbow Light* LP in January 2007. Both albums were released on self-run FRG Records and featured the core duo of

Bingham and Pescado augmented by various collaborators including vocalists Chris Gibbs and Sarah E. Three more focused, properly produced and mastered albums were released through RAIG.

In Spring 2009 they recruited J. D. Tait and Charlie Noakes.

This new line-up recorded the "Legends In Time" ep and bridged the old THC and the new THC. In 2009 they performed 5 shows in London using the programmed drums from their ep.

The band now find themselves in the final stages of recording their

second album "The Quest Into The Stepping Stone Age" which will hopefully be released some time in 2011.

OMNIA OPERA

In 2006 Omnia Opera reformed themselves. With the heart of the old band remaining intact they recruited new synth player Alf Hardy and two female singers Caitlin Beta and Plumaris. A second guitar was deemed necessary to bring the full scope of the Omnia Opera sound into the light of day so Steve Price (The Om band, THC) joined the ranks on rhythm guitar for their first gig. This finalised and provided the finishing touches to a new and improved Omnia Opera for the 21st century!

With Alf and the Clone Drones

leaving, Paul Bagley and Libby Vale joined Omnia Opera. Omnia Opera are about to release their new studio Album. Omnia Opera are now set to invade the future in good stead and fine fettle.



PARADISE9

Paradise 9 consists of Gregg McKella on main vocals, guitar, glissando guitar, clarinet, and space FX's, Carl Sampson on drums and backing vocals, with Neil Matthars on bass, joining the ranks in 2008. In 2007, Tyrone Thomas (Olympic Clamp Down / ex-Alternative TV / ex-Image Wot Image) was added to the line-up on lead guitar, thus making the current line-up. With this new line-up, Paradise 9 have developed a cutting edge, space-rock-stroke-punk rock sound. Jaki Windmill (Whimwise / ex-Space Ritual) now regularly guests on djembe and backing vocals.

The late great Judge Trev Thoms

(Inner City Unit), who sadly passed away in December 2010, also used to occasionally joined them live on lead guitar. The band are currently working on new material and album out for release soon.

Starfighters. Bob Calverts backing band. Jaime Cortinas on bass and Lugi Michael on drums are going to be joined by Dani Speakman and some guests.

Their set sometimes take in "Spirit Of The Age", "Assassins of Allah" and, obviously, a fair chunk of the Captain Lockheed album - "Catch A Falling Starfighter". In particular "Song Of The Gremlin", "Ground Control To Pilot", "Aerospaceage Inferno", "The Right Stuff" and "Ejection". They have been known to encore with "Orgone Accumulator". They also play some of their own songs.

Whatever they do they are helping to

keep Bob Calvert's music alive and for that we have to say good luck to them.

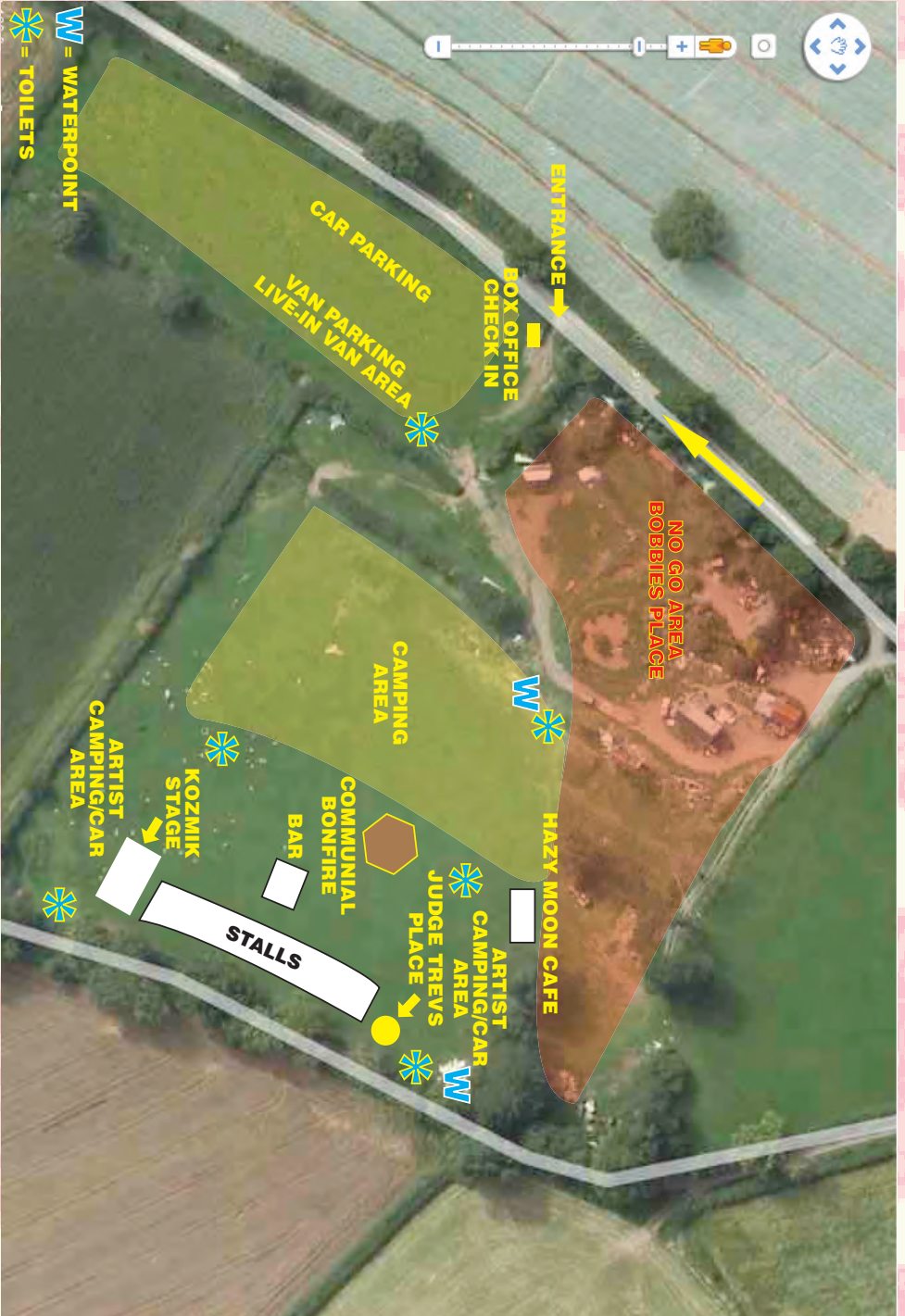
Formed in 2006 out of appreciation of our love for the ether and space rock.

In the late '60s / early '70s, he played in a blues-rock group called Iron Maiden - not the famous group of the same name - they recorded one album called Maiden Voyage.

He later played in Spirit of John Morgan. He has backed such luminaries as Graham Bond, Gregory Isaacs, Steve Gibbons and was a member of Steve Took's Horns.

After The Horns he joined Nik Turner in Inner City Unit. Thoms also worked with Turner and Twink in Pink Wind. He later formed Atomgods. He then

formed his own version of Inner City Unit called Judge Trev's Inner City Unit. A regular 'collaborator' he also played with the revived Pinkwind featuring Nik Turner & Twink (ex Fairies) and after moving to Brighton regularly appeared with Slim Tim Slide.

He played festivals such as the Big Green Gathering, Cosmic Puffin Festival, Glastonbury, Earthwise etc., performing solo acoustic sets or with a reformed Inner City Unit with Nik Turner. He also played gigs as Trev and Kev with Kev Ellis, singer/musician from Bubbledubble.

Thoms died on 8th December 2010.

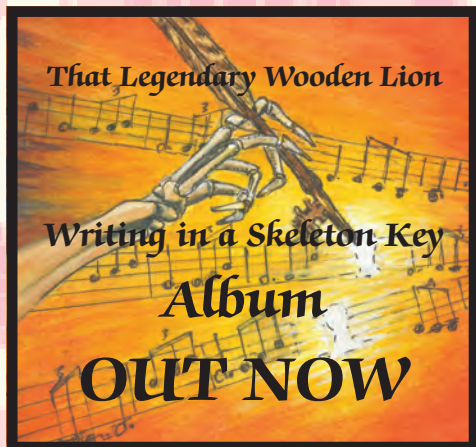

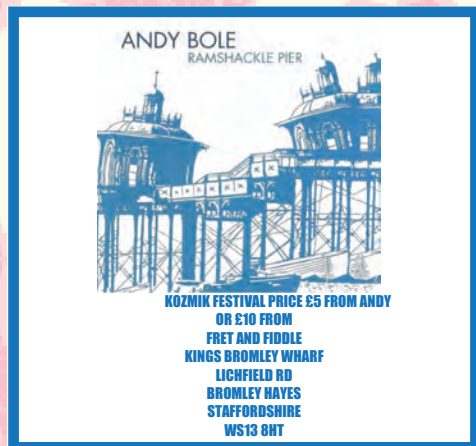

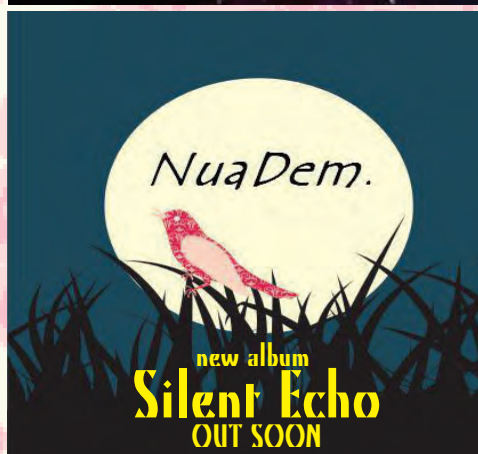
